"Sometimes it's the little things that make a big impact!

I was working in the food pantry at the Agape Center Lynchburg this past week, where our shelves had been recently stocked with these pounds of Starbucks ground coffee. This was the first time since we opened our doors that we've had ground coffee to give out in our food pantry.

A first-time client walked in and when she saw the coffee, she immediately started crying. I asked her if she was OK, and she responded by saying she was fine but just couldn't remember the last time she drank good coffee. She couldn't believe that we would not only send her home with coffee, among other groceries, but with really, good coffee. We were able to give her some of the best, just like Jesus would. That's pretty special.

Later that day I was helping another client load some groceries into her shopping cart and before she left, I gave her a hug and told her how happy I was she that she came in that day. She told me that never in her life had she been treated the way the volunteers at Agape treated her and Agape was different than anywhere else she'd ever been. Her comment made me so happy that she felt true Agape love from our volunteers, but it also broke my heart to think that she had experienced so little kindness in her life. And she is living within my community.

I realize I post a lot about Agape and I promise you it isn't because I'm awesome or care to brag about being there. I'm just doing what I know God has asked me to do. This center, the community behind it, and the clients who walk through our doors each week have changed my life and my perspective. It's also changing the lives of those who come in and I'd be remiss if I didn't share with my friends and family some of the incredible stories that come out of this place".....




Changing Lives, one need at a Time.....
