

A bed...a safe and warm place to sleep...don't you just love watching your children sleep, all cuddled up without a care in the world? It was a very busy day on a Tuesday in December, to say the least. From beginning to end, we barely had time to tie our shoes! At some point, during this day, a mother of three young children came in. She had been homeless, and as a result, voluntarily put her children in foster care so they would be safe. As of Tuesday, she was able to secure a home and was in need of beds for her children. This was the only way the court would let her have them back by Monday. We checked the warehouse and the only bed we had was a full. She needed either three twins or a full and one twin. First thing out of our mouth "we need to pray"...... I am not exaggerating when I tell you that VERY shortly afterwards, a man pulls up to the warehouse and says..."I have a twin bed, can you use it?" This mother burst into tears of joy knowing her precious children would be coming home. God is not slowing down! He is not only providing and showing Himself to those in physical need, but He is providing and showing Himself to many of us who may have been spiritually deficient. We love being able to watch God move and see Him express how much He cares for the clients, but my goodness, He doesn't stop there! We are **EXCITED** to have front row seats to watch the God-Stories that arise in 2020! **BRING IT GOD**, we are **READY**!

During that time she requested a Christmas tree. Unfortunately, we did not have one and when she finished up her time setting up her next appointment, she came back to shop. While she was shopping, another woman comes in the back way and said she has a pre-lit Christmas tree in her car and asked me if we could use it....mind you, this was the only donation she had and it was within 5-10 minutes of the client requesting a tree! Coincidence?!?! When the client was told a tree was just donated, she got teary eyed, a small crack was put in her wall as she shared how she told her family if they didn't have one before Thanksgiving, they weren't going to have one. We were able to point her back to how God loves her and her family and sees the desires of her heart. Even the woman who donated had goosebumps at the timing and was blessed by her single



Donation. And each time we see a Christmas tree, *lets all remember* it for more then being a pretty decoration! Agapes prayer for this client, so skeptical about God, sees this tree given to her family by the *God who sees her so clearly, loves her so unconditionally and longs to give her so much more than a tree.* God is showing up everyday at Agape Center Lynchburg, and it just *never gets old*!!
